Hill Chorlton

We are really pleased to have received even more comments from residents about what they want to see in the village. We now know that Hill Chorlton residents would like a new bench to replace the one we had to have removed and that they want to retain the flower tubs in the village.

Many of the issues raised are beyond our remit and are the responsibility either of the Borough Council or of SCC Highways. We are bringing these issues to the attention of the appropriate authority and will report back as soon as possible.

We are waiting to hear whether our application to the Staffordshire Road Safety Grant Fund for the installation of a Speed Indicator Device in Hill Chorlton has been successful. A further measure which would be likely to reduce speeds in the area is to introduce Community Speedwatch. This has the added advantage of not costing us anything as equipment and training would be provided free of charge but we would of course require a number of volunteers. Ice Busters

This is an initiative from SCC to support self-help groups – which includes Parish Councils – by providing them with advice and grit to treat footways and paths. Again this will require volunteers so please contact our clerk if you are interested.
